PurpleStride Charlotte 2017, a 5 K Run, 1 Mile Walk will take place on September 9, 2017 at 8:00 a.m. at First Ward Park. This community event is planned by volunteers of the Charlotte Affiliate of the Pancreatic Cancer Action Network and will pay tribute to loved ones who have succumbed to pancreatic cancer, as well as honor those who are currently fighting.

Elaine Smith, Team Captain for Team Lane said, "We have lost two wonderful managers to pancreatic cancer so this cause is dear to us. We at Lane Construction believe in giving back to the communities in which we work and live."

As the leading pancreatic cancer organization, PanCAN is working to expedite progress, improve patient outcomes and double survival by 2020 through key initiatives like <u>Precision</u> <u>PromiseSM</u> and <u>Know Your Tumor®</u>. The Pancreatic Cancer Action Network has raised more than \$87 million for the cause through community events from 2008 to 2016.

This year, an estimated 53,670 Americans will be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer, and approximately 43,090 will die from the disease. The five-year survival rate is just <u>nine percent</u>. PurpleStride Charlotte 2017 aims to improve patient outcomes by raising \$405,000 for the Pancreatic Cancer Action Network this year. Lane has raised more than \$19,000 the last two years.
